As we continue to move forward in these days First Baptist Church Edmonton (FBC) is taking the following steps to respond to the COVID-19 situation. These steps are intended to support the efforts of people in Edmonton, Alberta, and Canada to reduce the risk of disease and to limit the suffering that occurs because of the spread of illness.

- The Church Council meeting scheduled for March 17 is postponed. The meeting will be rescheduled as soon as possible, but no earlier than April 2020.
- Our FBC Annual General Meeting scheduled for March 19 is postponed, to be rescheduled for a date no earlier than April 2020.
- The Church Office will be open only virtually. This means email messages and phone messages will be returned, but staff will work at home. The church officers may be required to visit the office occasionally to sign cheques and other documents required for the operation of the church. Mail will be received and processed. No date has been set for reopening the office.
- Sunday-morning services on March 22 and 29, 2020, are cancelled. The first date on which Sunday-morning service may resume is April 5, 2020, but no decision has been made.
- All FBC-based events, gatherings, small groups, rehearsals, and rentals are suspended until further notice.

With the Congregation's implicit agreement, FBC continues to use the 2019 budget in March and April 2020, in anticipation of approving the 2020 budget at a congregational meeting as soon as that can be arranged.
