As we continue to adapt to these days of challenge, First Baptist Church Edmonton (FBC) is taking the following steps to respond to the COVID-19 situation. We do these things in the hope of reducing the risk of disease and of limiting the suffering that occurs because of the spread of illness.

- · Sunday services are planned for live broadcast using ZOOM videoconferencing, beginning at 11 a.m. on April 5, 12, 19, and 20. Instructions for tuning in using ZOOM will be provided in News and Notes and on the FBC Facebook page. Sermons will continue to be recorded and posted, along with the Order of Service, at the church's website fbcedmonton.ca.
- · The next Church Council meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, April 21, and will convene using videoconferencing.
- \cdot There are tentative plans to reopen the Church Office on May 5. This would be on a limited basis, that is, with only one member of staff present, on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday each week, from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m.
- The FBC Annual General Meeting remains postponed until a new date can be scheduled, no earlier than June 2020.
- · FBC continues to use the 2019 budget as a guide to expenditures and is identifying deferrals of some payments for the purpose of protecting the priorities of preserving our staff's livelihoods and maintaining the church building.
