Like the Good Samaritan, may we be quick to pour oil and wine into the wounded hearts of people everywhere, beginning with our brothers and sisters in this congregation. Heal and restore stability to all who suffer losses of many kinds -- such as health, a job or finances during this COVID Pandemic.

O God, send now a pandemic of love throughout our world for it is only when we truly love one another that we will see **your kingdom come and Your will being done on earth.**
