

Chrismons-Christ Monograms



CHI RHO-(Ky Ro) Chi Rho is the first two letters of the Greek word for Christ. Look at how the letter X forms the shape of a manger to remind us of Christ's birth.



LAMB-The Lamb is the symbol of Jesus Christ. (John 1:29) "The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world." It also reminds us that Christ is the Good Shepherd.



SHEPHERD'S CROOK-The Shepherd's Crook or Staff reminds us that Jesus is the Good Shepherd who cares for His people and we are invited to do the same. Shepherds were also the first people who were told about the birth of Jesus!



STAR-The eight pointed Armenian Star is also called the Bethlehem Star, showing us the way to Jesus, just as it did for the Magi.



CROSS AND CROWN-The cross is the symbol of salvation, the crown tells us that Christ is Lord. The faithful are promised the crown of life!



CROSS ON THE ORB-The Triumphant Cross shows the earth with the cross on top. It symbolizes Jesus reigns over heaven and earth.



FISH- Followers of Christ used the symbol of a fish as a secret sign to know who their friends were. The initials (IXOYC), the Greek word for fish, represented Jesus Christ, God's Son, and the Savior.



SUN- Reminds us of the light and mercies of God. Malachi 4:2 says, "the Sun of Righteousness shall arise with healing in his wings."



CHRISTMAS ROSE-The White Rose is a symbol for purity. Isaiah also prophesied that one day the desert would blossom as a rose.
