



LITANY OF PRAISE (adapted from Psalm 96)

Voice 1: Sing to the Lord a new song!

Sing to the Lord, all the earth!

Many: Sing to the Lord and bless the Lord's name,

tell of God's salvation from day to day.

Voice 2: Declare the glory of the Lord among the nations, and God's marvelous works among all peoples.

Many: For great is the Lord, and greatly to be praised, the Lord reigns above all gods.

Voice 3: Oh, the honor and majesty of the Lord's presence! The strength and beauty of God's sanctuary!

Many: Ascribe to the Lord, O families of the nations, ascribe to the Lord glory and strength.

Voice 4: Let the heavens be glad, let the earth rejoice; Let the sea roar, and all that fills it; Let the fields exult, and everything in them.

Many: Let the trees of the forest sing for joy, let all creation rejoice;

the Lord arrives, the Lord brings righteousness to the earth and to all peoples.






